FINAL ORDER

The Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Joseph Bossinger, and Samuel Jeje ("Respondent"), a resident producer, signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the above-captioned cause number, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of Insurance ("Commissioner") for approval.

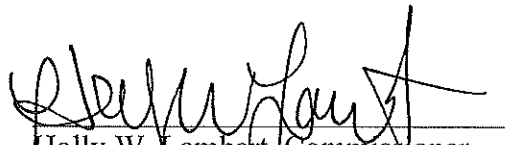
The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, that places Respondent on probation for a period of two (2) years due to Respondent having been terminated for cause from an insurance company after allegedly using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner as follows:

1. Respondent shall be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years beginning the date of this Final Order.
2. During the probationary period, Respondent shall submit a current list of appointments to the Department every six (6) months beginning from the date of this Final Order via email at: Enforcement@idoi.in.gov.
3. During the probationary period, in addition to any ethics-based continuing education courses required to maintain the license, Respondent shall successfully complete an additional six (6) hours of ethics-based continuing education courses each year and report the completion to the Department every twelve (12) months beginning from the date the Commissioner signs this Final Order via email at: Enforcement@idoi.in.gov.
4. During the probationary period, any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Respondent's license.
