MOTION TO RENEW EMERGENCY SUSPENSION

The Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Enforcement Division”), pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5-4 *et seq.*, files its Motion to Renew Emergency Suspension seeking to renew the suspension order issued against bail agent Timothy Charles Moyes (“Respondent”), and states:

1. Respondent has held bail agent license number 3895725 (“Respondent’s License”) since May 1, 2023.
2. Respondent’s License expires May 31, 2027.
3. On November 10, 2025, Respondent was criminally charged with Attempted Rape, a Level 3 Felony; Kidnapping, a Level 3 Felony; Criminal Confinement, a Level 3 Felony; Promotion of Human Sexual Trafficking, a Level 4 Felony; Burglary, a Level 4 Felony; Stalking, a Level 5 Felony; Sexual Battery, a Level 6 Felony; Four (4) counts of Failure of Bail Agent to Collect Full Premium, each Level 6 Felonies; Six (6) counts of Voyeurism, each Level 6 Felonies; Three (3) counts of Residential Entry, each Level 6 Felonies; Impersonation of a Public Servant, a Level 6 Felony; and Battery Resulting in Bodily

Injury, a Class A Misdemeanor, in Vanderburgh County, Indiana under cause number 82C01-2511-F3-006879.

4. The aforementioned criminal charges, in part, stem from allegations of Respondent's unlawful abuse of the functions, duties, and powers reserved for licensed bail agents.
5. Bankers Insurance Group ("Bankers") notified the Enforcement Division on November 19, 2025, that Respondent's representation with Bankers had been terminated due to Respondent violating of Indiana law.
6. The Enforcement Division filed a Motion for Emergency Suspension with the Commissioner of the Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on December 4, 2025, seeking immediate suspension of Respondent's License, to which the Commissioner issued her Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Emergency Order suspending Respondent's License, taking effect on December 4, 2025, and expiring on March 4, 2026.
7. The Enforcement Division filed a Motion to Renew Emergency Suspension with the Commissioner on February 26, 2026, citing its ongoing investigation and the significant threat to the safety of Indiana consumers posed by Respondent holding an active license, to which the Commissioner issued her Order Granting Motion to Renew Emergency Suspension, taking effect on February 26, 2026, and expiring on May 27, 2026.
8. The Enforcement Division filed a Motion to Renew Emergency Suspension with the Commissioner on May 18, 2026, citing its ongoing investigation and the significant threat to the safety of Indiana consumers posed by Respondent holding an active license, to which the Commissioner issued her Order Granting Motion to Renew Emergency Suspension, taking effect on May 18, 2026, and expiring on August 16, 2026.

9. Respondent is currently in custody awaiting jury trial under cause number 82C01-2511-F3-006879, which is set for September 28, 2026.
10. The Enforcement Division's investigation into this matter is ongoing.
11. The Enforcement Division believes Respondent continues to pose a significant threat to the safety of Indiana consumers such that Respondent's emergency suspension should continue until this matter is resolved.
12. Indiana Code § 4-21.5-4-5(b) provides that during the pendency of any related proceedings under Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3 the agency responsible for the proceeding may renew the order for successive ninety (90) day periods.

WHEREFORE, the Enforcement Division respectfully requests the Commissioner grant this motion to further suspend Respondent's License for a successive ninety (90) days and grant all other relief proper in the premises.
