Instructions: if you are able to personally mark your own ballot, complete and return application so it is received by county election board at least twelve (12) days before an election. **Deadline: For the June 2, 2020 Primary Election, deadline for county to RECEIVE is May 21, 2020, BY 11:59 p.m. (local prevailing time). For the June 2, 2020, primary election, a voter does not need to indicate a reason. If a voter has already submitted an ABS-MAIL application for the original primary date of May 5, 2020, there is no need to submit an application for the primary election. The original request will be reviewed by county election officials.**
