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Protocol to Screen IDEM Employee Grant Chaddock from Any Matter Regarding Environmental Consulting & Technology

Mr. Grant Chaddock is employed by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management ("IDEM") as an Enforcement Senior Case Manager within the Compliance and Enforcement Branch of the Office of Water Quality ("OWQ"). His duties include providing technical assistance to municipalities and industries and evaluating industrial compliance with environmental regulations. He coordinates environmental reviews of loan projects and maintains a tracking system on projects to ensure that IDEM's allocation of grant and loan monies are in accordance with original grant/loan requests. He reviews program plans for completeness, economic and technical feasibility, and environmental impact. He also performs annual audits on water pre-treatment programs.

Mr. Chaddock was recently approached through a head-hunting firm about a position with Environmental Consulting & Technology, Inc. ("ECT"). ECT is a multi-disciplinary environmental and sustainability consulting firm that provides permitting, design, and management solutions to public and private sector clients. The position is for a Senior Associate Scientist. The prospective duties include assistance with the preparations and editing of technical reports related to wetland delineations, vegetation mapping, environmental assessments, threatened and endangered species, habitat assessments, site investigations, mitigation compliance, and construction, as well as assistance with environmental permitting.

Mr. Chaddock is unaware of ECT's involvement in any matter to which IDEM has assigned him during his tenure at the agency. However, because ECT is an environmental consulting firm, there is a possibility that Mr. Chaddock could be assigned a matter in which ECT represents a party to that matter. Therefore, should Mr. Chaddock or IDEM become aware of ECT's representation or involvement in any matter, IDEM shall implement the following procedures to screen Mr. Chaddock to prevent a potential conflict of interest.

- 1. Ms Amari Farren is Mr. Chaddock's supervisor. She shall not assign any matter involving ECT to Mr. Chaddock. If she or Mr. Chaddock become aware of ECT's involvement in a matter, she shall re-assign that matter to another employee.
- 2. Mr. Chaddock shall recuse himself from the portion of any meeting in which discussions specific to ECT or any of its clients, if known, are discussed or are expected to be discussed.
- 3. Mr. Chaddock shall not discuss any matter involving ECT or its clients, if known, with any IDEM employee.
- 4. Ms. Farren will notify the employees in her section in writing that they are not to discuss any matter involving ECT with Mr. Chaddock or send him any emails concerning the company or its clients if known.

- 5. Mr. Chaddock shall not participate in decisions regarding or relating to ECT or any of its clients, if known.
- 6. Mr. Chaddock shall immediately inform his supervisor and IDEM Chief Ethics Officer Kathleen Mills if any provision of this screening protocol is violated.
- 7. Mr. Chaddock shall follow IC 4-2-6-9(b) and file a written disclosure statement with the State Ethics Commission.
- 8. Mr. Chaddock, Ms. Farren and Ethics Officer Mills shall review this screening protocol within 30 days from the date of the last signature to assure this protocol has been followed and determine if the protocol should continue.
