# CONFLICT OF INTEREST SCREEN FOR COTY CRAFT June 24, 2022

## RECITALS

T.

WHEREAS, Coty Craft is Utility & Railroad Coordinator for the Indiana Department of Transportation-Greenfield District ("INDOT" or "Department"); and

WHEREAS, Coty Craft has entered employment negotiations with Beam, Longest, and Neff, LLC ("BLN"); and WHEREAS, BLN has a business relationship with INDOT, including active contracts; and

WHEREAS, as Utility & Railroad Coordinator for INDOT- Greenfield, it is possible that Coty Craft could participate in matters in which BLN has an interest as part of his regular duties; and

WHEREAS, Coty Craft's employment negotiations with BLN created a potential decision and voting conflict of interest under IC 4-2-6-9 requiring disclosure and a formal screen; and

WHEREAS, Coty Craft is subject to the particular matter restriction (IC 4-2-6-11(a)) and cannot assist future employers, including BLN, with any matter he personally and substantially participated in for INDOT; and

WHEREAS, Coty Craft may have obtained confidential information in the course of his employment with INDOT and has an affirmative duty to protect such information from disclosure and to refrain from relying on such information for the benefit of himself or future employers.<sup>1</sup>

NOW THEREFORE, Coty Craft, Utility & Railroad Coordinator for INDOT- Greenfield District, for his remaining tenure with INDOT, or until he discontinues employment negotiations with BLN, agrees to in all ways follow, adhere to, and satisfy the terms of the following Conflict of Interest Screen. Coty Craft must adhere to terms three (3) and four (4) regarding the particular matter restriction and confidential information in perpetuity.

#### II. CONFLICT OF INTEREST SCREEN

- 1. Coty Craft shall not participate in any decision or vote, or any matter related to such decision or vote, in which BLN has a financial interest.
- 2. Coty Craft is screened from participating in any present or future contract or other matter involving BLN.
- 3. Coty Craft shall not assist any future employers, including BLN, with any matter he personally and substantially participated in while employed by INDOT. This restriction applies in perpetuity, for the life of the particular matter.
- 4. Pursuant to his duty under Ind. Code §5-14-3-10, Coty Craft shall not disclose or otherwise rely upon information classified as confidential under Ind. Code §5-14-3-4. This restriction applies in perpetuity, so long as the subject information is deemed confidential.

#### III. EMPLOYEE AFFIRMATION

I have read and understand the terms of the foregoing Conflict of Interest Screen, and will in all ways follow, adhere to, and satisfy the above stated restrictions on my participation in any decision or vote in which Beam, Longest, and Neff, LLC has a financial interest. I understand that the first two (2) terms of this screen terminate upon my leaving the Department or the discontinuation of negotiations with BLN, whichever occurs first. I further understand that terms three (3) and four (4) regarding particular matters and confidential information respectively, apply in perpetuity, for the life of each matter and so long as the subject information is deemed confidential.
