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CONFLICT OF INTEREST SCREEN FOR NICOLE FOHEYBRETING

I. RECITALS

WHEREAS, Nicole Foheybreting is Environmental Policy Office Manager for the Indiana Department of Transportation ("INDOT" or "Department"); and

WHEREAS, Nicole Foheybreting recently accepted employment with SESCO Group; and

WHEREAS, SESCO Group has a business relationship with INDOT, including active contracts; and

WHEREAS, as Environmental Policy Office Manager for INDOT, it is possible that Nicole Foheybreting could participate in matters in which SESCO Group has an interest as part of her regular duties; and

WHEREAS, Nicole Foheybreting's employment negotiations with SESCO Group created a potential decision and voting conflict of interest under IC 4-2-6-9 requiring disclosure and a formal screen; and

WHERAS, Nicole Foheybreting, as part of her regular duties as Environmental Policy Office Manager, is making oncall assignments for INDOT Project Des. No. 1005597 and Contract No. SP210001, as well as for environmental services provided to INDOT facilities Tibbs and New Castle, to each of which SESCO Group has been assigned; and

WHEREAS, Nicole Foheybreting must therefore be proactively screened from further participation in assigning consultants, or undertaking any other action or activity, related to said matters, This does not limit Nicole Foheybreting's ability to represent SESCO Group on future on-call work under Contract No. SP210001 that she did not participate in as INDOT employee; and

WHEREAS, Nicole Foheybreting is subject to the particular matter restriction (IC 4-2-6-11(a)) and cannot assist future employers with any matter she personally and substantially participated in for INDOT; and

WHEREAS, Nicole Foheybreting may have obtained confidential information during her employment with INDOT and has an affirmative duty to protect such information from disclosure and to refrain from relying on such information for the benefit of herself or future employers.¹

NOW THEREFORE, Nicole Foheybreting, Environmental Policy Office Manager for INDOT, for her remaining tenure with INDOT, or until she discontinues employment negotiations with SESCO Group, agrees to in all ways follow, adhere to, and satisfy the terms of the following Conflict of Interest Screen. Nicole Foheybreting must adhere to terms three (3) and four (4) regarding the particular matter restriction and confidential information in perpetuity.

II. CONFLICT OF INTEREST SCREEN

- Nicole Foheybreting shall not participate in any decision or vote, or any matter related to such decision or vote, in which SESCO Group has a financial interest, including INDOT Project Des. No. 1005597 and Contract No. SP210001, as well as environmental services at facilities Tibbs and New Castle. The post-employment screen does include future on-call work under Contract No. SP210001 that Nicole did not participate in as INDOT employee.
- 2. Nicole Foheybreting is screened from participating in any present or future contract or other matter involving SESCO Group, including the matters listed above under item (1), subject to the caveat regarding future on-call work that she did not participate in as an INDOT employee.
- 3. Nicole Foheybreting shall not assist future employers, including SESCO Group, with any matter she personally and substantially participated in as an INDOT employee. This restriction applies for the life of the matter.
- 4. Pursuant to her duty under Ind. Code §5-14-3-10, Nicole Foheybreting shall not disclose or otherwise rely upon information classified confidential under Ind. Code §5-14-3-4 so long as said information is deemed confidential.

III. EMPLOYEE AFFIRMATION

I have read and understand the terms of the foregoing Conflict of Interest Screen, and will in all ways follow, adhere to, and satisfy the above stated restrictions on my participation in any decision or vote in which SESCO Group has a financial interest. I understand that the first two (2) terms of this screen terminate upon my leaving the Department or the discontinuation of negotiations with SESCO Group, whichever occurs first. I further understand that terms three (3) and four (4) regarding particular matters and confidential information respectively, apply in perpetuity, for the life of each matter and so long as the subject information is deemed confidential. I have shared and discussed this Conflict of Interest Screen and its requirements with my supervisor and will specifically maintain strict separation from any decision or vote, or matter related to such decision or vote, pertaining to INDOT Project Des. No. 1005597 and Contract No. SP210001, as well as environmental services rendered by SESCO Group or any other consultant at INDOT facilities Tibbs and New Castle.
