Protocol To Screen IDEM Employee John Guerrettaz From Any Matter Concerning Duke Energy

John Guerrettaz is Chief of the Geology Section within the Office of Land Quality ("OLQ") at the Indiana Department of Environmental Management ("IDEM"). Duke Energy ("Duke") is a national power holding company whose operations in Indiana are regulated in part by IDEM. Mr. Guerrettaz supervises geologists that are involved in permitting and compliance activities with respect to geology and groundwater monitoring at various Duke sites across Indiana.

Mr. Guerrettaz and his family have entered into negotiations with a potential for litigation with Duke Energy as a result of damages caused by Duke to the family farm. To prevent the appearance of any decision being made as a result of a financial interest, IDEM has initiated the following protocol during the negotiations/potential litigation.

- 1. Mr. Guerrettaz shall recuse himself from any current or future matter that may arise involving Duke Energy.
- 2. Mr. Guerrettaz will not participate in any meeting in which Duke Energy is discussed.
- 3. Mr. Guerrettaz shall not access any correspondence or files relating to or involving Duke Energy.
- 4. Mr. Guerrettaz's supervisor, Permits Branch Chief Robin Feller, will notify in writing the employees in Mr. Guerrettaz's section that they are not to discuss any matter involving Duke Energy with Mr. Guerrettaz or send him any emails concerning it.
- 5. Mr. Guerrettaz's supervisor will assign any matters that may arise in the Geology Section regarding Duke Energy to a staff member other than Mr. Guerrettaz or handle the matter herself.
- 6. Mr. Guerrettaz shall immediately inform his supervisor and the IDEM Chief Ethics Officer if any provision of this screening protocol is violated.
- 7. Mr. Guerrettaz shall follow IC 4-2-6-9(b) and file a written disclosure statement with the State Ethics Commission.
- 8. All signatories to this protocol shall review it within thirty (30) days from the date of the last signature to determine if any revisions are necessary.
