Jeremy Hunter is the Managing Director of Asset Management for the Indiana Department of Transportation ("INDOT").

Jeremy Hunter has recently accepted employment with Clark Dietz, Inc. ("Clark Dietz").

Clark Dietz has a business relationship with INDOT, including active contracts with INDOT.

Jeremy Hunter's employment negotiations with Clark Dietz therefore created a potential decisions and voting conflict of interest under IC 4-2-6-9. This disclosure is therefore being filed in anticipation of that potential conflict.

Jeremy Hunter is not subject to the mandatory cooling off period (IC 4-2-6-11(b)) with regard to Clark Dietz.

Jeremy Hunter is subject to the particular matter restriction and will not assist future employers, including Clark Dietz, with any matter he personally and substantially participated in on behalf of INDOT.

This disclosure was provided to Mr. Hunter's appointing authority, Commissioner Kent Abernathy, on March 27, 2025.



CONFLICT OF INTEREST SCREEN FOR JEREMY HUNTER

March 27, 2025

I. RECITALS

WHEREAS, Jeremy Hunter is Managing Director of Asset Management for the Indiana Department of Transportation ("INDOT" or "Department"); and

WHEREAS, Jeremy Hunter recently accepted employment with Clark Dietz, Inc. ("Clark Dietz"); and

WHEREAS, Clark Dietz has a business relationship with INDOT, including active contracts; and

WHEREAS, as Managing Director of Asset Management for INDOT, it is possible that Jeremy Hunter could be assigned to participate in matters in which Clark Dietz has an interest as part of his regular duties; and

WHEREAS, Jeremy Hunter's employment negotiations with Clark Dietz created a potential decision and voting conflict of interest under IC 4-2-6-9 requiring disclosure and a formal screen; and

WHEREAS, Jeremy Hunter is subject to the particular matter restriction (IC 4-2-6-11(a)) and cannot assist future employers, including Clark Dietz, with any matter he personally and substantially participated in for INDOT; and

WHEREAS, Jeremy Hunter may have obtained confidential information in the course of his employment with INDOT and has an affirmative duty to protect such information from disclosure and to refrain from relying on such information for the benefit of himself or future employers.¹

NOW THEREFORE, Jeremy Hunter, Managing Director of Asset Management for INDOT, for his remaining tenure with INDOT, or until he discontinues employment negotiations with Clark Dietz, agrees to in all ways follow, adhere to, and satisfy the terms of the following Conflict of Interest Screen. Jeremy Hunter must adhere to terms three (3) and four (4) regarding the particular matter restriction and confidential information in perpetuity.

II. CONFLICT OF INTEREST SCREEN

1. Jeremy Hunter shall not participate in any decision or vote, or any matter related to such decision or vote, in which Clark Dietz has a financial interest.
2. Jeremy Hunter is screened from participating in any present or future contract or other matter involving Clark Dietz.
3. Jeremy Hunter shall not assist any future employers, including Clark Dietz, with any matter he personally and substantially participated in while employed by INDOT. This restriction applies in perpetuity, for the life of the particular matter.
4. Pursuant to his duty under IC 5-14-3-10, Jeremy Hunter shall not disclose or otherwise rely upon information classified as confidential under IC 5-14-3-4. This restriction applies in perpetuity, so long as the subject information is deemed confidential.

III. EMPLOYEE AFFIRMATION


