RE: Waiver of Application of 42 IAC 1-5-1 (the "Gift Rule") for Certain Items of Value That Were Received by INDOT Employees Attending the ICI Northern Winter Conference Held on January 25, 2018

Dear Mr. Clevenger:

Joe McGuinness, the appointing authority of the Indiana State Department of Transportation ("INDOT"), has designated authority to me as the agency's ethics officer to waive application of the Gift Rule in individual cases when consistent with the public interest. My authority under that designation continues until it is revoked or changed by the current INDOT Commissioner. I am hereby waiving application of 42 IAC 1-5-1(a) for the INDOT employees on the list that is attached to this letter and marked as Exhibit A so that they may attend the Indiana Constructors, Inc. ("ICI") event entitled "Northern Winter Conference" in Warsaw, IN on January 25, 2018.

The ICI event entitled "Northern Winter Conference" was held at the Hampton Inn, 115 Robmar Drive, Warsaw, IN 46580. The item of value that was received by INDOT employees attending the ICI event entitled "Northern Winter Conference" is food.

The \$5 cost for each INDOT employee in Exhibit A at the luncheon for this event will be paid for by ICI, which will use registration fees and other revenue obtained from its member companies as the source of payment. The value of the luncheon was given to me by Jason Spreen of INDOT. Some ICI member companies may have a business relationship with INDOT or may seek to influence an action by one or more INDOT personnel in his or her official capacity.

INDOT personnel covered by this waiver should not accept any other item of value from ICI or any other person, if that person may have a business relationship with INDOT or may seek to influence an action by one or more INDOT personnel in his or her official capacity. The safest course of action is for INDOT personnel to assume that anyone in the private sector attending the ICI event entitled "Northern Winter Conference" might have a business relationship with INDOT.



Some INDOT personnel are expected to participate in a presentation, and others will attend because this event is the beginning of an initiative to get more companies eligible to become prequalified by INDOT and the DBE private sector attendees at the event may have specialized questions or concerns that the other INDOT attendees will be able to address. Indiana Code 8-23-2-4.1(4)(A) provides that INDOT is responsible for the “construction, reconstruction, improvement, maintenance, and repair of (state) highways” and Indiana Code 8-23-2-5(a)(4) imposes upon INDOT the statutory duty in to “evaluate and utilize whenever possible improved transportation facility maintenance and construction techniques.”

Therefore, it is my opinion that it is consistent with the public interest for these INDOT personnel to attend the ICI event entitled “Northern Winter Conference” on January 25, 2018, and to receive the item of value specified above, even though payment for these items is being made by entities that may have a business relationship with INDOT. Based on this finding, I am hereby waiving application of 42 IAC 1-5-1(a) to the extent previously set forth in this letter.
