
Describe the conflict of interest:

As Chief of Staff and Chief Legal Counsel for the OIG, I currently review complaints and assist with legal action resulting from OIG investigations. I also make recommendations to the Inspector General on how to close investigations. I also serve as the OIG's Ethics Officer.

If the OIG receives a complaint or allegation of wrongdoing involving IUPUI, its employees or its affiliates, I will not be involved with the screening or evaluation of the complaint. The Inspector General will make any final decisions regarding any complaint, investigation or case involving IUPUI, including any decisions involving final disposition of such a case.
