Brief Description of Item Solicited, Accepted, or Received and approximate value of item:

The Postsecondary Employment Outcomes (PSEO) Coalition, a nonprofit coalition of higher education agencies and University systems, has invited two representatives from Indiana to attend the PSEO Summit 2025: Expanding the Education-to-Workforce Data Network, taking place April 30 and May 1, 2025 in Denver, Colorado. This invitation-only event will bring together postsecondary education, workforce, and data experts to collaborate on advancing integrated education-to-workforce data systems through the PSEO. Through generous support from the Strada Education Foundation, the PSEO Coalition will cover travel expenses for each invited representative, including airfare, two nights at the conference hotel, and out-of-pocket expenses such as parking and meals not provided by the conference. The approximate value of this sponsorship for the recipient is \$1,580 (\$330 for airfare, \$1,000 for hotel, \$100 for parking/taxi, and \$150 for meals).
