BF & S has a business relationship with INDOT, including active contracts. Prince's employment negotiations with BF&S, therefore, created a potential decisions and voting conflict of interest under I.C. 4-2-6-9. This disclosure is being filed in anticipation of that potential conflict. Greg Prince may not be subject to the mandatory cooling off period (IC 4-2-6-11(b)) with regard to BF&S. CONFLICT OF INTEREST SCREEN FOR GREG PRINCE June 9, 2025

I. RECITALS

WHEREAS, Greg Prince is a Project Manager for the Indiana Department of Transportation ("INDOT" or "Department")-Seymour District; and

WHEREAS, Greg Prince has accepted employment with Butler, Fairman & Seufert, Inc. ("BF&S"); and WHEREAS, BF&S has a business relationship with INDOT, including active contracts; and

WHEREAS, as a project manager for INDOT, it is possible that Greg Prince could be assigned to participate in matters in which BF&S has an interest as part of his regular duties; and

WHEREAS, Greg Prince's employment negotiations with BF&S create a potential decision and voting conflict of interest under IC 4-2-6-9 requiring disclosure and a formal screen; and

WHEREAS, Greg Prince is subject to the particular matter restriction (IC 4-2-6-11(a)) and cannot assist future employers, including BF&S, with any matter he personally and substantially participated in for INDOT; and

WHEREAS, Greg Prince may have obtained confidential information in the course of his employment with INDOT and has an affirmative duty to protect such information from disclosure and to refrain from relying on such information for the benefit of himself or future employers.¹

NOW THEREFORE, Greg Prince, Project Manager for INDOT, for his remaining tenure with INDOT, or until he discontinues employment negotiations with BF&S, agrees to in all ways follow, adhere to, and satisfy the terms of the following Conflict of Interest Screen. Greg Prince must adhere to terms three (3) and four (4) regarding the particular matter restriction and confidential information in perpetuity.

II. CONFLICT OF INTEREST SCREEN

- 1. Greg Prince shall not participate in any decision or vote, or any matter related to such decision or vote, in which BF&S has a financial interest.
- 2. Greg Prince is screened from participating in any present or future contract or other matter involving BF&S.
- 3. Greg Prince shall not assist any future employers, including BF&S, with any matter he personally and substantially participated in while employed by INDOT. This restriction applies in perpetuity, for the life of the particular matter.
- 4. Pursuant to his duty under Ind. Code §5-14-3-10, Greg Prince shall not disclose or otherwise rely upon information classified as confidential under Ind. Code §5-14-3-4. This restriction applies in perpetuity, so long as the subject information is deemed confidential.

III. EMPLOYEE AFFIRMATION

I have read and understand the terms of the foregoing Conflict of Interest Screen, and will in all ways follow, adhere to, and satisfy the above stated restrictions on my participation in any decision or vote in which BF&S has a financial interest. I understand that the first two (2) terms of this screen terminate upon my leaving the Department or the discontinuation of negotiations with BF&S, whichever occurs first. I further understand that terms three (3) and four (4) regarding particular matters and confidential information respectively, apply in perpetuity, for the life of each matter and so long as the subject information is deemed confidential.
