I also serve as the Curator of Native American Art at the Eiteljorg Museum of American Indian and Western Art in Indianapolis (the Eiteljorg). The Eiteljorg sponsors culturally relevant programming featuring Indigenous elders, speakers, artists, and scholars for educational opportunities for the public to learn about Indigenous cultures. In the future, the Eiteljorg may seek funding from INAIAC to fund these educational opportunities.

Any Eiteljorg funding application to INAIAC, possible voting, and awarding, would be a conflict of interest for me and would require screening. Code §4-2-6-10.5. Further, I will work with the Indiana Civil Rights Commission's Ethics Officer and INAIAC's Director to ensure this established screen is followed.
