I also serve a board member for the American Indian Center of Indiana, Inc. (AICI) in Indianapolis, Indiana. AICI sponsors culturally relevant programming featuring Indigenous elders and speakers, and provides community programs to serve Native Americans in Indiana. In the future, AICI may seek funding from INAIAC to fund these educational opportunities and programs.

Any AICI funding application to INAIAC, possible voting, and awarding, would be a conflict of interest for me and would require screening. In the event I learn AICI will apply for INAIAC funding, I will file a Conflicts of Interest - Contract Disclosure Statement prior to the funding request and INAIAC awarding any funds to AICI in order to fully comply with Ind. Code §4-2-6-10.5. Further I will work with the Indiana Civil Rights Commission's Ethics Officer and INAIAC's Director to ensure this established screen is followed.
