Describe the conflict of interest:

I retired from Barnes & Thornburg LLP (B&T) at the end of last year. I had joined B&T in 1984 and became a capital partner in 1992. Until around 2003, B&T had an unfunded retirement plan in which I was vested. By "unfunded," I mean that there is no money already set aside to pay the benefits. Rather, the benefits are paid out of B&T's current earnings. The plan was eliminated around 2003 and all the existing capital partners were grandfathered in. In January, 2025, I started receiving payments from B&T under the plan and I will continue to receive them in varying amount over the next ten years. The total amount I will receive is fixed. The percentage of the total I receive annually varies from 12.5% for the first two years, 10% for the next six years, and 7.5% for the last two years. The only way the amount could change based on B&T's financial performance is if for some reason B&T could not pay all or part of it, which is unlikely. The amount is meaningful to me and I would like to continue receiving the payments; however, the amount is likely between 0.01% and 0.02% of B&T's annual revenue. The Indiana Transparency Portal does not show any contracts directly between B&T and OMB. It does include some contracts between B&T and agencies that report up to OMB, such as IDOA, IOT, MPH, and SBA.

Potential conflicts that could arise in these circumstances include approving a contract with B&T or a B&T invoice, evaluating B&T's work for the State, or representing the State in a matter where B&T is adverse to the State.

Hi Lisa and Patrick,

I have received an informal advisory opinion and emails about the issue arising out of the B&T unfunded retirement payments I now receive. Among other things, they state that I am prohibited from participating in any matters in which B&T has a financial interest, such as a decision or vote to award a contract to B&T, to approve a B&T invoice, or to evaluate work done by B&T.

I also need to submit a disclosure form to the two of you concerning this matter. The disclosure form needs to be accompanied by my written notification to you of the potential conflict. Because my previous disclosures to you were in person rather than written, I am sending this confirming email. Briefly, in January I began receiving unfunded (paid out of current earnings) retirement payments from B&T and will continue to receive them for the next ten years. I will put more details in the disclosure form.
