Describe the conflict of interest:

In November 2017, Indiana Landmarks, a private 501(c)(3) organization based in Indianapolis, Indiana, requested sponsorship support from the Indiana Economic Development Corporation (IEDC) to commission an economic impact study on the effects of local historic designation as a catalyst for change, revitalization, neighborhood stability, and job creation. During the IEDC's sponsorship review process, the IEDC's General Counsel & Ethics Officer Ethics Officer identified that Ms. Bedel serves on the board of directors of Indiana Landmarks. Ms. Bedel, by virtue of her board position, has a financial interest (as defined in Indiana Code section 4-2-6-1(a)(11)), in Indiana Landmarks' sponsorship request to the IEDC. In the interests of transparency and out of an abundance of caution, the IEDC General Counsel & Ethics Officer identified this as a financial interest requiring an ethical screen and disclosure.

Describe the screen established by your ethics officer: *(Attach additional pages as needed.)*

As detailed in the Ethics Commission's Advisory Opinion 17-1-2, the IEDC has well-established ethical screening procedures. Ms. Bedel's membership on the Indiana Landmarks board of directors was logged into the IEDC's Customer Relationship Management (CRM) database, which is used to identify potential conflicts of interest. Ms. Bedel has been screened from any involvement in the sponsorship request review process. Ms. Bedel has not and will not discuss the Indiana Landmarks matter with IEDC staff, other than to disclose her board membership with Indiana Landmarks to the IEDC General Counsel & Ethics Officer. Ms. Bedel has not and will not participate in any discussion, decision, or vote related to the Indiana Landmarks sponsorship request, and Ms. Bedel will be completely screened from the matter.
