Describe the conflict of interest: Dr. David Freitas is currently employed as a Professor at the Indiana University South Bend campus. During the September 5, 2018, business meeting of the Indiana Board of Education ("Board"), the Board was set to discuss and vote to approve a teacher preparation program located at the Indiana University Purdue University-Columbus campuses. Participants in these programs are required to pay Indiana University tuition in order to attend these programs.		
Indiana Code 4-2-6-9 (Conflict of economic interest; commission advisory opinions; disclosure statement; written determinations) states in relevant part:		
(a) A state officer, an employee, or a special state appointee may not participate in any decision or vote, or matter relating to that decision or vote, if the state officer, employee, or special state appointee has knowledge that any of the following has a financial interest in the outcome of the matter:		

(3) A business organization in which the state officer, employee, or special state appointee is serving as an officer, a director, a member, a trustee, a partner, or an employee.		
Due to Dr. Freitas' employment with Indiana University South Bend, he recused himself from the discussion and vote regarding the teacher preparation program located at the Indiana University Purdue University-Columbus campus as his employer had a potential financial interest in the outcome of the vote.

The Board's ethics officer routinely reviews all materials presented to the Board to identify potential conflicts of interest for Board members. Additionally, Board members are required to engage in ethics training on a regular basis as required by state law.
