Describe the conflict of interest:
 I have interviewed for a position with Purdue University. The position is within the Division of Physical Facilities under the management of the Treasurer and CFO of Purdue University.

As Deputy Commissioner of Operations at INDOT, I am a voting member on INDOT's Joint Transportation Research Program (JTRP) Executive Committee. Through JTRP, INDOT collaborates with Purdue to advance research and innovative projects to improve Indiana's transportation infrastructure. The JTRP Executive Committee approves the annual JTRP work plan budget and research initiatives that get funded. Funding is allocated to research and implementation of research projects only (i.e. All funds go to academia under the management of the Provost of Academic Affairs; no JTRP funds are allocated to areas under management of the Treasurer and CFO of Purdue). Typical funding is ~\$5 million annually, and is in the form of 100% federal funds administered by INDOT.

Mark Tidd, INDOT's Ethics Officer, has established the following screen.

A. I have not attended a JTRP board meeting since September, and did not attend the Nov 30th meeting.
