On Nov. 23, 2015 I accepted a nursing position with Brown Mackie College Central Services as the Dean of the College of Nursing. I work assessing, advising, and consulting with all Brown Mackie nursing programs to provide support and recommendations for improvement. This includes the Brown Mackie nursing programs in Indiana as well as other states. Part of the responsibility of the nursing board is to review school curriculum and make recommendations and vote on accreditation status.

The screen established by the Ethics Officer for the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency requires Natalie Hall to absent herself from any room or venue in which any matter related to Brown Macke College might or will take place. In addition, Natalie Hall will have no contact whatsoever with any other Indiana State Board of Nursing board member or staff of the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency, other than the agency's Ethics Officer, concerning any matter related to Brown Macke College. In addition, Indiana Professional Licensing Agency staff assigned to the Indiana State Board of Nursing have been advised not to engage Natalie Hall in discussions about or send her any communications or information regarding Brown Macke College. This communication prohibition does not prohibit the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency staff from sending board meeting agendas to Ms. Hall; however, any board packets sent to her in advance of any board meetings must be redacted to remove any materials in any way related to Brown Macke College. The official minutes memorializing all action taken by the Indiana State Board of Nursing must include an affirmative statement that Ms. Hall absented herself from the venue and did not participate in the decision-making in any manner. Moreover, the official minutes related to Brown Macke College must include an affirmative statement listing the Indiana State Board of Nursing board members who did, in fact, participate in discussions and/or votes concerning Brown Macke College.


