Describe the conflict of interest:
On June 14, 2018, the Indiana Economic Development Corporation ("IEDC") Board of Directors considered an application from Riverview FW, LLC ("Riverview") for the approval of Community Revitalization Enhancement District (CRED) tax credits to help finance its proposed mixed-use development project (the "Project") in Fort Wayne, Indiana. In addition to the CRED tax credits, Riverview indicated in its application that it would also be seeking conventional bank financing from one of a select number of pre-identified lenders, one which is STAR Financial Bank ("STAR"). Prior to the meeting, Ms. Marcuccilli notified the IEDC's General Counsel & Ethics Officer that she is the Senior Vice President & Chief Operating Officer for STAR. Ms. Marcuccilli, by virtue of her senior leadership position with STAR, has a potential financial interest (as defined in Indiana Code section 4-2-6-1(a)(11)), in Riverview's application for CRED tax credits. Although it has not yet been determined whether STAR will be selected to provide financing for the Project, in the interest of transparency and out of an abundance of caution, the IEDC General Counsel & Ethics Officer identified this as a financial interest requiring an ethical screen and disclosure.

Describe the screen established by your ethics officer. (Attach additional pages as needed.)

As detailed in the Ethics Commission's Advisory Opinion 17-I-2, the IEDC has well-established ethical screening procedures. Ms. Marcuccilli's senior leadership position with STAR was logged into the IEDC's Customer Relationship Management (CRM) database, which is used to identify potential conflicts of interest. Ms. Marcuccilli was screened from any involvement in the Riverview matter. Ms. Marcuccilli has not and will not discuss the Riverview matter with the IEDC staff or members of the IEDC Board of Directors, other than to disclose her senior leadership position with STAR to the IEDC's Ethics Officer. When the IEDC Board of Directors conducted its public meeting on June 14, 2018, Ms. Marcuccilli recused herself from any discussion, decision, or vote related to the Riverview matter and was completely screened from the matter.
