Describe the conflict of interest:					
On June 5, 2017, the Indiana Economic Development Corporation (IEDC) Board of Directors will meet to consider					
a grant to Dallara USA Holding, Inc. (Dallara) to support research, development and manufacturing of race car components					
that will be purchased by Verizon IndyCar Series race teams. Prior to the meeting, Mr. Miles notified the IEDC General Counsel					
& Ethics Officer that Mr. Miles is the Chief Executive Officer of INDYCAR, LLC (INDYCAR), Indianapolis Motor Speedway, LLC (IMŚ),					
and IMS Productions, Inc. (IMSP). INDYCAR, IMS and IMSP are subsidiaries of Hulman & Company (Hulman). Mr. Miles					
is the President and CEO of Hulman.					
INDYCAR has contracts with Dallara, LLC to designate Dallara, LLC as an approved supplier of race car components					
to the Verizon IndyCar Series. IMS has contracts to license space to Dallara USA for use during events at the Indianapolis					
Motor Speedway. IMSP does not have any contracts with Dallara, Dallara, LLC or any other Dallara-related legal entities.					
Hulman, IMS, INDYCAR and IMSP do not have any ownership interest in any of the race teams participating in the					
Verizon IndyCar Series. In addition, based upon INDYCAR's and IMS's contracts with Dallara, LLC and Dallara USA,					
respectively (which are the only contracts Hulman and its subsidiaries have with Dallara and its related legal entities), neither					
Hulman, IMS, INDYCAR, nor IMSP has a direct financial interest in the IEDC's pending grant to Dallara nor in any benefit that					
accrues under the grant to the Verizon IndyCar race teams. Hulman, INDYCAR, IMS and IMSP may, by virtue of contracts

with race teams and Dallara, have an indirect financial interest (as defined in Indiana Code section 4-2-6-1(a)(11)), in the IEDC's pending grant to Dallara. In the interests of transparency and out of an abundance of caution, the IEDC General

Counsel & Ethics Officer identified this as a financial interest requiring an ethical screen and disclosure.

Describe the screen established by your ethics officer: (Attach additional pages as needed.) As detailed in the Ethics Commission's Advisory Opinion 17-I-2, the IEDC has well-established ethical screening					
procedures. The relationship of Mr, Miles' business with Dallara was logged into the IEDC's Customer Relationship					
Management (CRM) database, which is used to identify potential conflicts of interest. Mr. Miles will be screened					
from any involvement in the Dallara matter. Mr. Miles has not and will not discuss the Dallara matter with IEDC staff					
or members of the IEDC Board of Directors, other than to disclose his business relationship with Dallara to the IEDC					
General Counsel & Ethics Officer. When the Business Development Committee of the IEDC Board conducts its public					
meeting on June 5, 2017, Mr. Miles will be asked to recuse himself from any discussion, decision, or vote related to the					
Dallara matter, and Mr. Miles will be completely screened from the matter. Subsequently, during the public meeting of the					
entire IEDC Board. Mr. Miles will also recuse himself and will be completely screened from	n any discussion, decision, or				
vote related to the Dallara matter.
