Specifically, matters involving variances that are being requested by RATIO, or as part of a project in which RATIO is involved, or any other matter in which RATIO may have a financial interest.

In the event that RATIO has a financial interest in a request for a variance from the Commission, is a party to an appeal of a building code violation, or has a financial interest in any project or matter that is brought before the Commission, Mr. Pannicke will recuse himself from the discussion of the matter, as well as the decision or vote on the matter.
