



MAY BENEFIT RATIO**


Scott Pannicke serves as a Commissioner on the Indiana Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission ("Commission"). In this role, Mr. Pannicke is responsible for participating in decisions and votes regarding matters that come before the Commission.

Mr. Pannicke also works as an Architect for RATIO, which is an architecture and design firm that completes projects in Indiana and throughout the country. In this role, Mr. Pannicke serves as a specification manager and manages projects, which generally involves writing project technical and bid specifications.


In accordance with the state ethics laws and to avoid any potential conflict of interest or appearance of impropriety, Scott Pannicke will be screened from all Commission decisions and votes on matters that might potentially involve, to its benefit or detriment, RATIO. Specifically, matters involving variances that are being requested by RATIO, or as part of a project in which RATIO is involved, or any other matter in which RATIO may have a financial interest.

In the event that RATIO has a financial interest in a request for a variance from the Commission, is a party to an appeal of a building code violation, or has a financial interest in any project or matter that is brought before the Commission, Mr. Pannicke will recuse himself from the discussion of the matter, as well as the decision or vote on the matter.
