Describe the conflict of interest:
Paul Peaper is a Senior Operations Director in the Office of the Governor. He has served in this capacity since January 2017. In this role, Mr. Peaper's primary responsibility is to serve as the liaison between various agencies and the Governor's Office. His portfolio includes and is primarily composed of the public health agencies in the executive branch including agencies such as the Indiana State Department of Health, the Family and Social Services and the Indiana Department of Insurance. In this capacity, Mr. Peaper works closely with the agencies in his portfolio to effectively communicate the Governor's agenda. He also serves as the Governor's Office liaison to business and community organizations, and other public and private entities on public health matters. Mr. Peaper has indicated that he intends on engaging IU Health to seek employment.

Mr. Peaper's portfolio includes agencies that interact with and/or regulate IU Health. Accordingly, the

Governor's Ethics Officer has instituted a screen to prevent Mr. Peaper from participating in any matter or decision that may disproportionately affect IU Health.
