IC 20-20-43 et seq. established the "System for Teacher and Student Advancement Grant Fund Program." WCCSC has applied for a grant pursuant to this program.

Indiana Code 4-2-6-9 (Conflict of Economic Interest; Commission Advisory Opinions; Disclosure Statement; Written Determinations) states in relevant part:

(a) A state officer, an employee, or a special state appointee may not participate in any decision or vote, or matter relating to that decision or vote, if the state officer, employee, or special state appointee has knowledge that any of the following has a financial interest in the outcome of the matter:

(3) A business organization in which the state officer, employee, or special state appointee is serving as an officer, a director, a member, a trustee, a partner, or an employee.

During the February 5, 2020, Board meeting, an action item labeled "B. Approval of Career Ladders Grants," which included a potential grant award for WCCSC, was presented to the Board. The term "Career Ladders" refers to the "System for Teacher and Student Advancement Grant Fund and Program. Due to Ms. Rentschler's position with WCCSC, which had a financial interest in the outcome of the matter, Ms. Rentschler did not participate in the discussion or vote when the Board reached this agenda item.


