Protocol to Screen IDEM Employee Kim Rohr From any matter regarding AES Corp.

Ms. Rohr is a Senior Environmental Manager within the Office of Water Quality ("OWQ") at the Indiana Department of Environmental Management ("IDEM"). Her duties in the position include sewer ban coordinator, lab and operation assistance and wastewater facility inspector. As sew ban coordinator, she analyzes flows of municipal wastewater treatment plants to ensure the facilities are not operating the plant above what it is designed to treat. She inspects wastewater treatment facilities for compliance with their NPDES permits and provides lab training and trouble shooting of operational issues at small treatment plants.

Ms. Rohr has recently applied for a position of Senior Analyst, Environmental, Health and Safety with AES Corp. at a facility formerly known as IPL (Indianapolis Power and Light). The responsibilities of the prospective position include:

- Ensuring compliances at the Harding Street Station, Georgetown, and Eagle Valley Station facilities
- Counseling and training personnel on the scope of all current environmental regulations
- Compiling environmental operating data for transmittal to governmental agencies
- Assuring accuracy of the environmental operating data through quality assurance programs
- Reviewing operational data for violations and trends and reporting all violations and/or problems to the appropriate entity
- Assisting personnel in solving any environmental regulatory violations or problems
- Inspecting the facility to ensure compliance.

Ms. Rohr is currently not assigned any matters involving AES Corp. However, she did, on one occasion, inspect the IPL Eagle Valley facility for NPDES permit compliance when another IDEM employee, who was assigned the facility to inspect, was unable to do so.

IDEM will institute the following protocol.

- 1. Office of Water Quality ("OWQ") Enforcement and Section Chief, Samantha Groce, is Ms. Rohr's immediate supervisor. SC Groce will not assign to Ms. Rohr any current or future matter that may arise involving AES Corp.
- 2. Ms. Rohr shall recuse herself from the portion of any meeting in which discussions specific to AES Corp. are discussed or are expected to be discussed.
- 3. Ms. Rohr shall not discuss any matter involving AES Corp. with any IDEM employee.
- 4. SC Groce will notify the employees in Ms. Rohr's section, in writing, that they are not to discuss any matter involving AES Corp. with Ms. Rohr or send her any emails concerning the corporation.
- 5. Ms. Rohr shall not access any correspondence or files relating to or involving AES Corp.

- 6. Ms. Rohr shall not participate in decisions regarding or relating to AES Corp.
- 7. Ms. Rohr shall immediately inform her supervisor and the IDEM Chief Ethics Officer if any provision of this screening protocol is violated.
- 8. Ms. Rohr shall follow IC 4-2-6-9(b) and file a written disclosure statement with the State Ethics Commission.
- 9. All signatories to this protocol shall review it within thirty(30) days from the date of the last signature to assure it has been followed and determine if the circumstances have changed to make the protocol no longer necessary.
