Describe the conflict of interest:  
Joshua Williams works as an Elevator and Amusement Ride Inspector for IDHS; however, he also owns an amusement ride company that operates within Indiana. This company receives permits from the IDHS and may be periodically inspected by the IDHS. Therefore, Mr. Williams must be screened from performing inspections of, issuing any permits for, and any other decision or matter relating to his amusement ride business, Goodtime Amusements, LLC.

ETHICS POLICY CONCERNING DECISIONS THAT MAY BENEFIT  
GOODTIME AMUSEMENTS, LLC

Joshua Williams serves as an Elevator and Amusement Ride Inspector for the Indiana Department of Homeland Security (IDHS). In this role, Mr. Williams is responsible for performing inspections of elevators and amusement rides and issuing permits for elevators and amusement rides.

Mr. Williams also owns Goodtime Amusements, LLC, which is an amusement ride company located in Rolling Prairie, IN, that provides ride equipment and personnel to run the equipment, usually for small festivals and church picnics in Indiana. Mr. Williams estimates that Goodtime Amusements, LLC, is hired to provide amusement rides at approximately 25 events per year. These events occur primarily on the weekends and will not interfere with Mr. Williams' regularly scheduled work hours with IDHS.

In accordance with the state ethics laws and to avoid any potential conflict of interest or appearance of impropriety, Joshua Williams will be screened from all Indiana Department of Homeland Security decisions and matters that might potentially involve, to its benefit or detriment, Goodtime Amusements, LLC. The Elevator/Amusement Ride & Boiler/Pressure Vessels Section Chief for the Division of Fire & Building Safety will retain complete decision-making authority, to the full extent currently delegated to Joshua Williams, with respect to any decision or delegation of any decision which would potentially result in a benefit (or detriment) to Goodtime Amusements, LLC. This includes, but is not limited to, the inspection of rides and/or issuance of permits for Goodtime Amusements, LLC.

When a matter arises that would normally be submitted to or discussed with Joshua Williams, if the matter involves an issue which could even potentially result in a benefit (or detriment) to Goodtime Amusements, LLC, or involves Goodtime Amusements, LLC in any way, the matter shall be directed to the IDHS Elevator/Amusement Ride & Boiler/Pressure Vessels Section Chief.
