**Call to Order and Roll Call:**

Chairman Michael B. McMains called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m. local time. A quorum was present.

**Approval of the Minutes:**

Upon motion by Marc Fine, second by Joseph Svetanoff, and unanimous vote of those present, the Commission approved the proposed minutes from the August 28, 2019 Business Meeting.

**Report of the Executive Director:**

Executive Director Tait began her report by introducing the new commissioner, Jason Dudich. He was the state budget director, and Ms. Tait acknowledged that we are thrilled to have him join the team. Ms. Tait acknowledged former commissioner Rich McClain for his service and dedication to the Gaming Commission. Acknowledgment was given to Caesars Entertainment for their land-based casino and hard work. The Indiana Gaming Commission hired three people since the last meeting: Liz Sullivan as a Receptionist, Jerri Cox as an Accountant, and Mike Bowlby as a Charity Gaming Investigator. There were five promotions: Zach Wilkinson from Gaming Agent to Background Investigator, Bill Peevler from Field Auditor to Charity Gaming Investigator, Jeffrey Ware from Program Coordinator to Assistant Director of Compliance, Brad McQuitty from Central Zone Assistant Director to Assistant Director of Operations, and Andy Fuller from Gaming Agent Supervisor to Central Zone Assistant Director. This semester we have a legal intern, Chris Neal. Since the August 2019 Business Meeting, Commission staff has added 15 individuals to the Exclusion List, 11 waivers were granted, and a three year supplier reinvestigation for Midwest Game Supply was completed.

Monthly revenue reports, including sports wagering, have been posted to the IGC website. Voters in Vigo County voted on and passed a referendum consenting to an inland casino and gambling at Tuesday's election. The IGC has updated answers on its website regarding the Vigo County applications and proposals, and we are extending the application submission deadline to December 2, 2019.

In order to ensure an accurate Commission record, two matters require reporting to the entire Commission. Spectacle Entertainment requested an interim waiver to conduct a debt transaction which was approved on September 9, 2019. Subsequently, Spectacle requested that the interim waiver be withdrawn and IGC staff consented to that request. In addition, Commission Order 2019-174 is void as the Order contained conditions, one of which was not met. The IGC's website has been updated to reflect that the Order is no longer effective.

The Commission meetings for 2020 have not yet been set, but the first Commission meeting typically occurs in March and to avoid any gaps in coverage of the rule, staff presented the Sports Wagering emergency rule and a 90-day extension to the Commission.


**Presentation:**




