

**RESOLUTION 1995- 37**

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE EXECUTIVE  
DIRECTOR THE AUTHORITY TO GRANT IEP, LTD.  
A TEMPORARY SUPPLIER'S LICENSE**

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. IEP, Ltd. ("IEP") supplies surveillance equipment to riverboats and casinos. The supplier of surveillance systems is required to be licensed as a supplier pursuant to 68 IAC 2-2-2. Aztar Indiana Gaming Corporation (Aztar) wishes to purchase its surveillance equipment from IEP.
2. IEP submitted a complete application for a supplier's license and the \$5,000 application fee to the Commission on September 25, 1995.
3. Delaying the installation of the surveillance equipment until after the preliminary background investigation can be completed by the Indiana State Police, Gaming Enforcement Section, to ensure that IEP meets the criteria set forth in IC 4-33-7-3 for licensure as a supplier will delay the opening of Casino Aztar.
4. The Indiana State Police, Gaming Enforcement Section has begun the background investigation on IEP.
5. Aztar is aware that the preliminary investigation has not been completed on IEP, and has agreed that the surveillance equipment will be removed if the Commission determines that IEP is not suitable for licensure.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

**SECTION 1. SCOPE.**

This resolution applies to IEP, Ltd.

**SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.**

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

**SECTION 3. ACTION GRANTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR THE AUTHORITY TO GRANT IEP, LTD. A TEMPORARY SUPPLIER'S LICENSE ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY SUPPLIER'S LICENSES.**

The Commission grants the Executive Director the authority to issue a temporary license to IEP upon an indication, based upon a partial preliminary background investigation conducted by the Indiana State Police, Gaming Enforcement Section, that the complete preliminary investigation will likely determine that IEP will meet the criteria for licensure as a supplier set forth in IC 4-33-7-3. The temporary supplier's licenses will remain valid until the date that permanent supplier's licenses are issued or until the temporary supplier's license is revoked pursuant to 68 IAC 2-2 or the conditions set forth in this resolution.

**SECTION 4. CONDITIONS PLACED ON TEMPORARY SUPPLIER'S LICENSE AND GRANT OF AUTHORITY TO EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO PLACE ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS ON THE TEMPORARY LICENSE.**

(a) The Commission hereby places the following conditions on a temporary supplier's license for IEP if such license is issued by the Executive Director:

1. That the temporary supplier licensee pay all costs associated with the completion of the background investigation to the extent the amount exceeds the application fee that was paid pursuant to IC 4-33-7-1 and 68 IAC 2-2-2.
2. That the temporary supplier licensee sign an affidavit acknowledging the conditions that are placed on the issuance of the temporary supplier's license.

(b) The Commission hereby grants to the Executive Director the authority to place additional conditions on the issuance of the temporary supplier's license, including but not limited to, the following conditions:

1. That the temporary supplier licensee comply with the conditions set forth in paragraph (a) above.
2. That the temporary supplier licensee maintain the records set forth in IC 4-33-7-5 and furnish the information set forth in IC 4-33-7-5 to the Commission.
3. That the temporary supplier licensee maintain its records in a manner consistent with Commission directives pursuant to IC 4-33-4-6.

4. That the temporary supplier licensee obtain, maintain, or both, insurance in a minimum amount determined by the Executive Director. The temporary supplier licensee shall obtain, maintain, or both, the following types of insurance:
  - (A) Liability.
  - (B) Casualty.
  - (C) Capital loss.
  - (D) Fire.
  - (E) Theft.
  - (F) Worker's compensation insurance.
  - (G) Any other type of insurance the Commission or the Executive Director deems necessary to ensure the temporary supplier licensee is adequately insured.
5. That the temporary supplier licensee continue to cooperate fully with the Indiana State Police Gaming Enforcement Section in the completion of the background investigation.
6. That the temporary supplier licensee comply with all rules and resolutions that are adopted by and under which the Commission operates pending final promulgation of the rules.
7. That the temporary supplier licensee continue to maintain suitability for licensure set forth in IC 4-33 and 68 IAC and that the temporary supplier licensee continue to comply with all requirements set forth in IC 4-33 and 68 IAC.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This RESOLUTION is effective immediately.

**SECTION 6. EXPIRATION DATE.**


This RESOLUTION expires upon the issuance or denial of a permanent supplier's license to IEP.
