

**RESOLUTION 1998-14**

**CONDITIONAL APPROVAL OF  
THE GAME OF SUPER SEVENS**

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. IC 4-33-2-9 and 68 IAC 10-1-1 set forth those games that are approved for use in Indiana. IC 4-33-2-9 and 68 IAC 10-1-1 authorize the game of Twenty-one or Blackjack in Indiana.
2. Essex Enterprises has submitted the game of Super Sevens and asked that the Commission consider approving it for use in Indiana.
3. Casino Aztar has advised the Commission, in writing, that it supports the game of Super Sevens for use in Indiana, and Aztar has submitted proposed rules of the game which it will utilize if the game of Super Sevens is approved.
4. Gaming Laboratories International, Inc. (“GLI”) has reviewed the information and material submitted by Essex Enterprises. GLI has forwarded its report to the Commission and has found that the game of Super Sevens is a variant of the game of Twenty-one or Blackjack.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

**SECTION 1. SCOPE.**

This resolution applies to all riverboat licensees and Essex Enterprises.

**SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.**

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

**SECTION 3. CONDITIONAL APPROVAL OF THE GAME OF SUPER SEVENS.**

The game of Super Sevens is approved for a trial period of six (6) months for use on Indiana riverboats. During the trial period, all riverboats who offer the game of Super Sevens must report those matters as directed by the Executive Director or the Executive Director’s designee, at a minimum, the following information: the amount of play, the revenue generated by the game of Super Sevens, and whether the riverboat licensee wishes to continue offering the game of Super Sevens. The riverboat licensee must also document any customer complaints or

incidents that are generated by the game of Super Sevens and forward those reports to the Commission. At the end of the trial period, the Commission will consider approving the game of Super Sevens to be offered on Indiana Riverboats on a permanent basis.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This RESOLUTION is effective immediately.
