

RESOLUTION 2000-6

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE ORIGINAL EMERGENCY RULE ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION ON JANUARY 27, 2000

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The Commission has considered the following factors:

1. Pursuant to IC 4-33-4-3 and IC 4-22-2-37.1, the Commission used its authority to adopt an emergency rule on January 27, 2000.
2. Pursuant to IC 4-33-4-3, the Commission is to commence rulemaking procedures not later than thirty (30) days after the adoption of the emergency rule. Accordingly, a notice of intent to formally adopt this rule was published in the January 1, 2000 edition of the *Indiana Register*. In further promulgation of the rule, the proposed rule was published in the March 1, 2000 edition of the *Indiana Register*. While the emergency rule is in effect, the Commission will proceed with the formal rulemaking procedures set forth in IC 4-22-2 so that the amendment may be formally adopted before the renewed emergency rule expires.
3. The Commission staff will file the extension of the emergency rule with the Secretary of State and submit it for publication with the Legislative Services Agency. The emergency rule will be effective through July 29, 2000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to each applicant, each licensee, each riverboat license applicant, any person who does business with an applicant or licensee, and any person who is a patron of a Riverboat Gambling Operation.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. ADOPTION OF THE EMERGENCY RULE.

The Commission re-adopts the following rule as an emergency rule:

Article 3 Minority and Women's Business Enterprises
68 IAC 3-3-3 Goals

The Commission hereby resolves that the Emergency Rule adopted by the Commission on January 27, 2000 will remain in effect through April 30, 2000. Pursuant to IC 4-22-2-37.1(g), the Commission hereby extends the effectiveness of the original emergency rule by again adopting the rule as an emergency rule to become effective May 1, 2000 and remain effective for ninety (90) days thereafter. The Commission further adopts any stylistic, grammatical, typographical, or other nonsubstantive changes that the Commission or the Legislative Services Agency may make to this emergency rule. The Commission shall submit the rule to the Publisher of the *Indiana Register* and the Indiana Administrative Code and to the Secretary of State for filing. The Commission will expeditiously complete the process necessary to adopt the emergency rule as a final rule pursuant to the dictates of IC 4-22-2.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.


The emergency rule adopted in section 3 of this resolution is to become effective May 1, 2000.
