

RESOLUTION 2000-20

**A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE REQUEST OF
NORTH AMERICAN VIDEO, INC.
TO WITHDRAW ITS APPLICATION FOR A SUPPLIER'S LICENSE**

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The Commission has considered the following factors:

1. On or about June 4, 1999, North American Video, Inc. ("NAV") submitted an application for a supplier's license to the Commission.
2. NAV's application for licensure lacked required information. Rather than submit the requested information, NAV opted to request leave to withdraw its application for a supplier's license pursuant to 68 IAC 2-2-4(d).
3. On or about May 5, 2000, the Commission received a written request from NAV whereby NAV requested leave to withdraw its application for a supplier's license (copy of letter attached).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING
COMMISSION THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to NAV.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. REQUEST TO WITHDRAW.

The request of NAV for leave to withdraw its application for a supplier's license, received on May 5, 2000 is hereby:

GRANTED


