

RESOLUTION 2000-35

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE REQUEST OF LOGICAL SOLUTIONS INTERNATIONAL, INC. TO WITHDRAW ITS APPLICATION FOR A SUPPLIER'S LICENSE.

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6:

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. On or about March 28, 1996, Logical Solutions International, Inc. (LSI) submitted an application for a supplier's license to the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission").
2. On or about May 20, 1996, the Commission granted LSI a Temporary Supplier's License.
3. On or about June 12, 1998, the Commission granted LSI a Permanent Supplier's License.
4. On or about June 12, 1999 and June 12, 2000, the Commission granted the Renewal of LSI's Permanent Supplier's License.
5. On or about August 7, 2000, the Commission received a written request from LSI whereby LSI requested the ability to terminate its status as a Permanent Supplier Licensee (copy of letter attached).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to Logical Solutions International, Inc.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. REQUEST TO WITHDRAW.

The request of Logical Solutions International, Inc. to withdraw its status as a Permanent Supplier Licensee, received on August 7, 2000, is hereby:
