

RESOLUTION 2001-29

**A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE REQUEST OF
BUD JONES COMPANY, INC. FOR A SUPPLIER'S LICENSE**

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6:

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. In accordance with IC 4-33-8 and 68 IAC 2-2, suitable applicants for a Supplier's License are issued a Supplier's License with the completion of a background investigation.
2. Supplier's Licenses are issued to applicants to supply goods and services to gambling operations licensed by the Indiana Gaming Commission.
3. The Bud Jones Company, Inc. ("Bud Jones") received a Temporary Supplier's License on October 17, 1995, a Permanent Supplier's License on August 19, 1997, and a renewal of the Supplier's License on August 19, 1998, August 20, 1999, and August 20, 2000.
4. On or about September 22, 2000, the Commission received a Transfer of Ownership Application from Bourgogne et Grasset due to the purchase of The Bud Jones Company, Inc. By Resolution 2000-41 dated October 23, 2000, the Commission granted the request for leave to withdraw the supplier's license of The Bud Jones Company, Inc.
5. The Commission has completed a background check on The Bud Jones Company, Inc. and Bourgogne et Grasset as substantial owner and is ready to issue them a Supplier's License.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING
COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to Bourgogne et Grasset, S.A. and The Bud Jones Company, Inc.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

**SECTION 3. GRANT OF SUPPLIER'S LICENSE FOR QUALIFIED
APPLICANT.**

The Commission hereby grants a Supplier's License to The Bud Jones Company, Inc. The Supplier's License will be valid for a period of one (1) year, from August 23, 2001 through August 22, 2002.

SECTION 4. CONDITIONS PLACED ON SUPPLIER'S LICENSE.

- A. Issuance of the Supplier's License is conditioned upon payment of the cost of the license investigation and the payment of \$5,000 annual license fee in accordance with IC 4-33-7-1 and 68 IAC 2-2 by September 10, 2001. Failure to remit payment may result in the revocation of their license.
- B. The supplier licensee maintains the records set forth in IC 4-33-7-5 and furnish the information set forth in IC 4-33-7-5 to the Commission.
- C. The supplier licensee maintains its records in a manner consistent with Commission directives pursuant to IC 4-33-4-6.
- D. The supplier licensee obtain, maintain, or both, insurance in a minimum amount determined by the Executive Director. The supplier licensee shall obtain, maintain, or both, the following types of insurance:
 - (1) Liability.
 - (2) Casualty.
 - (3) Capital loss.
 - (4) Fire.
 - (5) Theft.
 - (6) Worker's compensation insurance.
 - (7) Any other type of insurance the Commission or the Executive Director deems necessary to ensure the permanent supplier licensee is adequately insured.
- E. The supplier licensee comply with all rules and resolutions that are adopted by and under which the Commission operates pending final promulgation of the rules.
- F. The supplier licensee continue to maintain suitability for licensure set forth in IC 4-33 and 68 IAC and that the supplier licensee continue to comply with all requirements set forth in IC 4-33 and 68 IAC.
- G. The supplier licensee must request renewal of the Supplier's License at least thirty (30) days before the expiration of the Supplier's License in accordance with 68 IAC 2-2-8.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This RESOLUTION is effective immediately.
