

## **RESOLUTION 2005-31**

### **APPROVAL OF THE REQUEST OF PRIME TABLE GAMES TO WITHDRAW ITS REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF THE GAME OF 2-2-1**

The Indiana Gaming Commission (Commission) adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The Commission has considered the following factors:

1. IC 4-33-2-9 and 68 IAC 10-1-1 set forth those games that are approved for use in Indiana. Both IC 4-33-2-9 and 68 IAC 10-1-1 authorize the game of Pai Gow Poker.
2. Prime Table Games submitted the game of 2-2-1 for approval for play on Indiana riverboats. Gaming Laboratories International, Inc. ("GLI") reviewed the information submitted by Prime Table Games and found that the game is a variation of the traditional game of Pai Gow Poker.
3. Prime Table Games received conditional approval of the game for a period of six (6) months, pursuant to Resolution 2004-4, which was adopted by the Commission on February 6, 2004.
4. Caesars Indiana ("Caesars") sponsored 2-2-1 by introducing the game to its casino floor following the conditional approval. Caesars advised Commission staff that the game was removed from the casino floor in September of 2004 due to low player popularity, low drop and win, and the game's slow pace.
5. Prime Table Games has advised Commission staff that there are no probabilities of future interest in the game. Prime Table Games has further requested that its request for approval of 2-2-1 be withdrawn.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION,  
THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

#### **SECTION 1: SCOPE**

This resolution applies to all riverboat licensees and Prime Table Games.

#### **SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS**

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.
