

ORDER 2006-7

**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
CONCERNING THE RENEWAL OF
CHIPCO INTERNATIONAL'S SUPPLIER'S LICENSE**

In accordance with and subject to Indiana Code 4-33 and 68 IAC 2-2 of the Indiana Administrative Code, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") previously issued a permanent supplier's license to Chipco International ("Chipco").


A supplier's license is valid for a period of one (1) year and in accordance with IC 4-33-7-8 and 68 IAC 2-2-8, a supplier license must be renewed annually along with the payment of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) for the annual renewal fee. Chipco requested a renewal of licensure on August 16, 2005 and submitted the renewal fee in accordance with 68 IAC 2-2-3(c) and 68 IAC 2-2-8. In the renewal request, Chipco advised the Commission of multiple disciplinary actions of various types that had been taken against Chipco in other jurisdictions including British Columbia, Canada. An investigation by the Commission staff revealed that the British Columbia Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General ("British Columbia Ministry") cancelled the Interim Registration of JOM, Inc. (dba Chipco International).

Pursuant to Resolution 2005-48, the Commission extended Chipco's supplier's license on September 26, 2005 for a period of six (6) months so that Commission staff could further investigate the actions taken against Chipco by the British Columbia Ministry. The results of the investigation are necessary to determine whether the licensee is in compliance with the Indiana Gaming Act pursuant to IC 4-33-7-8. Chipco's six (6) month extension expires on April 23, 2006.

To date, Commission legal staff has received and analyzed numerous documents from Chipco and has commenced communications with the British Columbia Ministry, but has found that additional investigation and analysis are necessary. The Executive Director has authorized that the matter be turned over to the Background and Financial Investigations Section of the Division of Gaming Agents to assist in completing the investigation and devising a proposal for a final course of action by the Commission at its next business meeting.

In order to enable Commission staff sufficient time to complete its investigation into the matters surrounding the British Columbia action, the Commission hereby **GRANTS** a further extension of Chipco International's Indiana Supplier's license for a period of approximately **THREE (3) MONTHS**. The extended Supplier License will remain valid until June 30, 2006 or such earlier date when the Commission reconvenes for its regularly scheduled second quarter business meeting. All other terms and conditions of Resolution 2005-48 will continue to apply to Chipco during the extended period.
