ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION RENEWING THE RIVERBOAT OWNER'S LICENSE OF RIH ACQUISITIONS IN, LLC


On April 21, 2005 in accordance with and subject to Indiana Code 4-33 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") approved the request of RIH Acquisitions IN, LLC ("Resorts") to acquire the riverboat owner's license held by Showboat Marina Casino Partnership ("Harrah's). On the same date, the Commission renewed the license for a period of one year from April 15, 2005 to April 14, 2006.


On February 27, 2006, Resorts requested renewal of the riverboat owner's license and submitted payment of the annual renewal fee in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000).


Pursuant to Indiana Code section 4-33-6-12, the Commission has found that Resorts is in compliance with the directives of Indiana Code 4-33 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code. The Commission **GRANTS** renewal of Resorts' riverboat owner's license for a period of one year, valid from April 15, 2006 to April 14, 2007. Said renewal is subject to the following conditions approved by the Commission:


1. Resorts is to continue providing Commission staff with a remote dial-in to Resorts slot and account management system.
2. Resorts is to maintain a bond in the amount of \$2,765,000 to secure its economic obligations.
3. Resorts is to continue to maintain its commitment to the Commission's 10% and 5% goals of Minority and Women's Business participation, respectively.
4. Resorts is to keep its riverboat gambling operation, the riverboat, the hotel, and the pavilion in compliance with all relevant state and local laws and regulations including, but not limited to, all properly applicable Commission rules, regulations and directives relating to the lawful operation of riverboat gaming in Indiana.
