ORDER 2006-40 ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

RE: ADAM J. COMBS 05-OL-CA-1

On or about December 21, 2004, Mr. Combs, Occ.Lic. No. CA6993-L3, was issued a permanent occupational license to work for Caesars Casino as a General Maintenance Mechanic. On December 5, 2005, Mr. Combs notified the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") about an arrest that occurred on December 24, 2004. Mr. Combs submitted court documentation to the Commission that showed that he had pleaded guilty to Criminal Recklessness, a Class A Misdemeanor.

Mr. Combs failed to submit to a Commission Agent the information relating to his arrest within ten (10) calendar days of the occurrence of the event, in violation of 68 IAC 2-3-9.1. On or about January 3, 2006, the Commission initiated a disciplinary action against Mr. Combs pursuant to its duty and power to execute, fully and effectively, the riverboat Gambling Act and its authority to initiate appropriate disciplinary action against a licensee. Mr. Combs agreed to a settlement of this matter. The settlement agreement is attached and incorporated by reference.

Having considered the foregoing and the attached settlement agreement, the Commission hereby:

the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
