
After having reviewed the attached Settlement Agreement, the Indiana Gaming Commission hereby:

**SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) by and through its Executive Director, Ernest E. Yelton and Belterra Casino and Resort (“Beltterra”) desire to compromise and settle this matter prior to the initiation of a disciplinary proceeding pursuant to 68 IAC 13-1-18(a). The parties stipulate and agree that the following facts are true:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Pursuant to IC 4-33-9-12(a), “a person who is less than twenty-one (21) years of age may not be present in the area of a riverboat where gambling is being conducted.” Pursuant to 68 IAC 1-11-1(c), “[a] person under twenty-one (21) years of age shall not be present on a riverboat.”
2. On February 4, 2006, two underage patrons were identified on the Belterra vessel by a Champion’s Club employee. Surveillance footage shows that the two minors entered the casino through the turnstiles and that Security personnel did not ask them to present identification.

**RECOMMENDATION TO THE COMMISSION**

The actions of Belterra in the Findings of Fact violated Indiana Code 4-33-9-12(a) and title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, specifically, 68 IAC 1-11-1(c).

The Commission staff and Belterra agree that a sanction be imposed due to the actions stated in the Findings of Fact. The Commission staff recommends and Belterra will agree to pay a fine in the amount of \$13,500.


Upon execution and approval of this Settlement Agreement, Belterra and the Commission staff agree to submit this Settlement Agreement to the Commission for review and final Commission action. Upon approval of the Settlement Agreement by the Commission, Belterra agrees to remit payment in the amount of \$13,500 and waives all rights to judicial review. This Settlement Agreement shall be binding upon the Commission and Belterra.
