ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
REGARDING THE REQUEST OF ELISABETH STRECKFUS
FOR A WAIVER OF 68 IAC 2-3-5 (c) (10)

On or about November 22, 2005, Elisabeth Streckfus, Occ. Lic. No. BC6708-L1, applied for a Level 1 license to be a Captain of the Blue Chip Casino. Ms. Streckfus disclosed in her application that she had been convicted of Driving Under the Influence in Illinois in 1994. Pursuant to 68 IAC 2-3-5(c)(10), "an applicant whose duties will be to operate or navigate the riverboat must not have violated any criminal statute involving drugs or alcohol, or both, in any jurisdiction." In a letter dated February 9, 2006, Ms. Streckfus submitted a written request to the Commission for waiver of 68 IAC 2-3-5(c)(10). The investigation into Ms. Streckfus by the Commission staff found her to be otherwise suitable to hold a Level 1 license.

Having considered the foregoing and based on the following additional factors:

1. the age and nature of the offense;
2. the fact the offense was an isolated incident; and
3. the petitioner's disclosure the offense on her application;

the Commission hereby:
