

**ORDER 2010-103**

**AN ORDER DENYING THE APPEAL OF VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION  
REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #30 (VEP 09-62)**

On June 11, 2009, in Order 2009-62, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) approved remittance of \$2,280.00 against John Doe #30 for the reason that John Doe #30 was a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program at the time John Doe #30 won a \$2,280.00 jackpot while in the gaming area of Ameristar Casino in East Chicago, Lake County, Indiana.

On July 8, 2009, John Doe #30 filed with the Commission a request for hearing to review Order 2009-62. On or about February 10, 2010, Commission staff filed a Motion for Summary Judgment with Administrative Law Judge Michael Cook for the reason that there were no factual issues in dispute and that the Administrative Law Judge could make a ruling based solely on those undisputed facts and applicable law. On March 19, 2010, Judge Cook held a hearing on staff’s motion. On March 22, 2010, Judge Cook issued his confidential Order in this matter, which included a recommendation that the Commission summarily deny John Doe #30’s petition for review of Order 2009-62.

**COMMISSION ACTION**


After reviewing the foregoing, and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:
