

**ORDER 2010-39**  
**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION**  
**CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF A MINORITY OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN**  
**ATLANTIC CITY COIN & SLOT SERVICE COMPANY, INC. TO ALEA PARTNERS, LLC**

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following order pursuant to authority granted it under IC 4-33.

Atlantic City Coin & Slot Service Company, Inc. ("AC Coin") is licensed by the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") as a supplier. It provides various gaming products to Indiana casinos. ALEA Partners, LLC ("ALEA") has entered into an agreement to acquire a minority interest in AC Coin. AC Coin will continue as a legal entity and will continue to hold the supplier license.

In addition to the above, the Commission has considered the following factors in contemplating the parties' request for approval of the proposed transfer of ownership interest:

1. AC Coin and ALEA have submitted to the Commission transfer of ownership applications and personal disclosure forms for all Substantial Owners and Key Persons as deemed necessary by Commission staff.
2. The Commission's Background and Financial Investigations sections have completed a comprehensive investigation of ALEA, and, coincidentally, a re-investigation of AC Coin including both companies' Substantial Owners and Key Persons. Commission staff has presented confidential final investigative reports of both companies and the Key Persons of both companies to the Commission for review.
3. AC Coin and ALEA have presented sufficient evidence that both entities meet or possess the standards, qualifications, or criteria necessary to be issued a supplier's license pursuant to 68 IAC 2-2-5, 68 IAC 5-2-2(d), and IC 4-33-7.


**COMMISSION ACTION**

Based on the foregoing, and in accordance with 68 IAC 5-2, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the transfer of a minority ownership interest in AC Coin to ALEA.

The Commission's approval is contingent upon the following: (1) successful closing of the agreement; (2) submission to Commission staff of all final documents material to effectuating the agreement, and (3) acceptance of the continuing condition that AC Coin, ALEA, and all relevant affiliates, Key Persons, and Substantial Owners remain in full compliance with all laws, regulations and/or other directives which are applicable to this acquisition, and/or to a supplier licensee in the State of Indiana.
