

ORDER 2011-127

**APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION AND CUT THROAT MMA**

On or about October 26, 2010, Cut Throat MMA ("Promoter") received from the Indiana Gaming Commission a promoter's license. Under that license, Promoter conducted professional mixed martial arts events on November 6, 2010 and February 19, 2011.

Promoter failed to timely provide to the Commission the ticket stubs and unsold tickets as required under LSA Document #10-782(E), Section 26(d)(2) for both events.

On March 25, 2011, Commission staff sent a letter to Promoter regarding this matter. This letter offered to settle the matter in lieu of commission staff filing a complaint and pursuing disciplinary action.

Commission staff and Promoter have agreed to settle this matter. The terms of the settlement agreement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, require Promoter to pay a fine of three hundred dollars (\$300).

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
