

ORDER 2011-170

**AN ORDER REGARDING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT REGARDING
KYLE SANDERS APPEAL OF HIS PLACEMENT ON THE STATEWIDE
EXCLUSION LIST**

On April 8, 2010, while employed as a Dealer at the Belterra Casino, Kyle Sanders was observed on four separate occasions allegedly moving tip bets made by patrons in order to increase his odds of winning and paying tip bets that were not winning wagers while dealing at a 21 + 3 Blackjack game. On October 26, 2010, pursuant to 68 IAC 6-1-3(2), the Executive Director placed Sanders on the Statewide Exclusion List as a result of his actions. Sanders filed a timely notice of appeal and Michael Cook was appointed to serve as the Administrative Law Judge.

Commission staff entered into settlement discussions with Sanders and offered to settle this matter by affirming the placement of Sanders on the Commission Exclusion List while allowing him to petition for removal from the exclusion list after one year and six months. On July 1, 2011, Sanders accepted the settlement. On July 15, 2011, the Administrative Law Judge issued an order approving the settlement agreement.

COMMISSION ACTION


After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with 68 IAC 7-1-15, the Commission hereby:


