

**ORDER 2011-261**  
**REGARDING THE COMMISSIONS CLAIM AGAINST**  
**KNOCK OUT SPORTS EVENT SURETY BOND**

On April 13, 2011, the Commission issued to Knock Out Sports Promotions ("Promoter"), promoter's license number BP000002, under which it conducted a professional boxing event on July 30, 2011, in Gary, Indiana. As required by IC 4-33-22-32 and LSA Doc #11-559(E), Section 21, Promoter obtained a \$10,000 surety bond conditioned upon "the payment of tax imposed, the officials and contestants, and the compliance with this chapter and the valid rules of the Commission."

Although some required payments have been made, Promoter has failed to make all payments necessary under IC 4-33-22 and LSA Doc #11-559(E). Under Resolution 2010-127, the recovery of required payments through the exercise of the promoter's bond must be approved by the Commission.

Commission staff seeks the Commission's authority to initiate a claim against the Promoter's bond in the event that the Promoter fails to make all required payments no later than November 28, 2011.

**COMMISSION ACTION**

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-33-22 and LSA #11-559(E), the Commission hereby:

**APPROVES**


the recovery of required payments through the exercise of the Promoter's bond in the event Promoter fails to make all required payments in full no later than November 28, 2011.
