

ORDER 2013-042

AN ORDER AFFIRMING THE CIVIL PENALTY AGAINST CHRISTOPHER CONTE FOR VIOLATION OF HIS PLACEMENT ON THE STATEWIDE EXCLUSION LIST

On May 6, 2011, Christopher Conte was placed on the Statewide Exclusion List, barring his presence on the gaming floor at any casino in Indiana. On May 16, 2012, Conte was found at the Rising Star Casino in Rising Sun, Indiana in violation of the terms of the placement on the Statewide Exclusion List. While in the gaming area of the Rising Star Casino, Conte possessed \$225 in gaming chips.

On November 19, 2012, Commission staff initiated a civil penalty administrative action by filing a complaint against Conte in the amount of \$225 for being in violation of 68 IAC 6-1-4.5. Conte failed to file an Answer to the Commission's complaint. On February 11, 2013, the Administrative Law Judge issued a Default Judgment Order against Conte for failure to respond to the Commission staff's civil penalty administrative complaint.

COMMISSION ACTION


After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

the Administrative Law Judge's Order. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.


