

ORDER 2013-046

AN ORDER REGARDING THE REQUEST FOR HEARING REGARDING THE VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #12-92

On November 15, 2012, in Order 2012-158, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") approved remittance of \$5,055 against John Doe #92 for the reason that John Doe #92 was a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program at the time John Doe #92 was discovered in possession of \$5,055 in gaming chips while in the gaming area of the Hollywood Casino in Lawrenceburg, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #12-92 timely filed with the Commission a request for a hearing on Order 2012-158. Administrative Law Judge Michael Cook was assigned to the case. On February 26, 2013, Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #12-92. The settlement agreement was subsequently approved by the Administrative Law Judge.

COMMISSION ACTION

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

AFFIRMS

the Administrative Law Judge's Order. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.
