

ORDER 2013-191

**AN ORDER REGARDING THE APPEAL OF THE
VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #13-43**

On June 27, 2013, in Order 2013-074, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) approved remittance of \$1,000.25 against John Doe #13-43 for the reason that John Doe #13-43 was a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program at the time John Doe #13-43 won a jackpot for \$1,000.25 while in the gaming area of the Ameristar Casino in East Chicago, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #13-43 timely filed with the Commission an appeal of Order 2013-074. Administrative Law Judge Michael Cook was assigned to the case. On November 7, 2013, Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #13-43. The settlement agreement was subsequently approved by the Administrative Law Judge.

COMMISSION ACTION

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

AFFIRMS

the Administrative Law Judge’s Order. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.


