

ORDER 2014-81

**AN ORDER REGARDING THE APPEAL OF THE
VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #13-58**

On June 27, 2013, in Order 2013-089, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) approved remittance of One Thousand Nine Hundred Thirteen Dollars and Twenty Five Cents (\$1,913.25), before applicable taxes, against John Doe #13-58 for the reason that John Doe #13-58 was a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program at the time John Doe #13-58 won a jackpot for One Thousand Nine Hundred Thirteen Dollars and Twenty Five Cents (\$1,913.25) while in the gaming area of the Horseshoe Hammond Casino in Hammond, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #13-58 timely filed with the Commission an appeal of Order 2013-089. Administrative Law Judge Michael Cook was assigned to the case. On April 2, 2014, Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #13-58. The settlement agreement was subsequently approved by the Administrative Law Judge.

COMMISSION ACTION

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

APPROVES

the Settlement Agreement between Commission staff and John Doe #13-58. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.


