

ORDER 2014-88
APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE INDIANA
GAMING COMMISSION AND JILL RUF

On or about November 8, 2013, Jill Ruf ("Ms. Ruf") was issued a level 2 temporary license and temporary identification badge to work at Ameristar Casino as a Human Resources Director. During a background investigation, Commission investigators determined additional information from Ms. Ruf was necessary. A Commission investigator gave Ms. Ruf a chance to provide the necessary information via a letter she received on December 30, 2013, with a thirty (30) day deadline to respond. Ms. Ruf failed to respond in any way and failed to provide the requested information.


An applicant for occupational license must comply with all requests for information, documents, or other materials relating to the applicant and her application during the investigation conducted by the Commission. 68 IAC 2-3-5(b)(9).

Commission staff and Ms. Ruf have agreed to settle this matter in lieu of Commission staff pursuing disciplinary action. The terms of the settlement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, provide that Ms. Ruf will voluntarily relinquish her temporary license and temporary identification badge for a period of three (3) unpaid regularly scheduled working days, without using vacation or any other paid leave time.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.


